AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR, AND, IF AWARDED, TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT FOR A GRANT THROUGH THE 2019 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Council created the Cuyahoga County Supplemental Block Grant program administered in conjunction with, and using the same grant process as, the County Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Supplemental Block Grant program is funded through the Casino Revenue Fund, distributed by Cuyahoga County and administered by the Cuyahoga County Department of Development; and

WHEREAS, application projects must meet a community development need related to the health or welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, the projects to be submitted by the City of Berea for consideration in the competitive process are identified on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to make application for, and, if awarded, to enter into a Cooperation Agreement with the County Executive of Cuyahoga County and the Department of Development for the Cuyahoga County Supplemental Grant program for 2019, providing for the use of Cuyahoga County Supplemental Grant program funds on the projects identified on Exhibit "A".


SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, and for the further reason that the City must meet the filing deadline in order to be considered eligible to receive the grant funds. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage an approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.



City of Berea – Citywide Bike Improvement Program

Project Description

This project will accomplish citywide improvements to various bike facilities within the City of Berea. Improvements will include replacement of existing bike racks, installation of bike racks in new locations, installation of bike maintenance stations, signage, and other bike accessibility improvements. All new equipment will be selected to complement existing infrastructure in parks or along streetscapes. The City has identified several locations where bike improvements are needed. The locations include Coe Lake, the Recreation Center, City playgrounds, Cleveland Metropark's access locations, and within downtown Berea.

The City will be applying for a Community Development Supplemental Grant (CDSG) for this project for an amount of up to \$50,000. If the grant is awarded, the project will be implemented between April and September 2019 during the CDSG program term.
