AN ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING THE CITY OF BEREA MUNICIPAL SAFE STUDENTS FUND, TO BE KNOWN AS FUND NO. 241, FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECORDING FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OTHER SCHOOL ORGANIZATIONS, POTENTIAL GRANTS, DONATIONS, AS WELL AS TRANSFERS FROM THE CITY'S GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUNDS. THE EXPENSES WILL BE PAYROLL EXPENDITURES FOR SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS, TRAINING, EQUIPMENT NEEDS, AND OTHER OPERATING AND CAPITAL EXPENDITURES BUDGETED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council unanimously passed Resolution 2013-7, which expressed support for the School Resource Officer program and outlined the necessity for school security measures; and

WHEREAS, the City desired to create a special Safe Students Fund to be used for the purpose of paying for operating and capital costs associated with security measures in our schools.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 1901.36, the Director of Finance be and she is hereby authorized and directed to establish a Safe Students Fund, which shall be designated for accounting purposes as Fund No. 241 for the purpose of receiving and accounting for all funds from various sources including but not limited to the school district, other school organizations, potential grants, donations as well as transfers from the City's General Fund and other funds.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to establish the fund so that moneys received may be properly accounted for in compliance with all applicable laws. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




