ACKNOWLEDGING APRIL 22, 2014, AS EARTH DAY, AND APRIL 25, 2014, AS ARBOR DAY, AND PROMOTING AND ENCOURAGING ALL RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF BEREA TO CULTIVATE AND APPRECIATE TREES AND ALL ARBOREAL GIFTS OF NATURE.

WHEREAS, April 22, 2014 is the 44th Anniversary of Earth Day Celebrations; and

WHEREAS, Arbor Day was first proposed in 1872 as an annual tree-planting day and is currently celebrated annually across the country on the last Friday of April; and

WHEREAS, trees provide numerous benefits to the community which include contributing to cleaner air and providing aesthetic beauty, color and variety in the environment, in addition to soil erosion prevention, shade, sound buffering, privacy and texture in the landscape, and a home for animals, birds and insects; and

WHEREAS, the Year 2014 is the twenty-sixth year in which the City of Berea has been designated Tree City U.S.A., and the City hereby wishes to continue to promote and encourage beautification of the environment by the planting and maintaining of shade trees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City, the President and all of the Members of Council, the Officers of the Administration and the Members of the Shade Tree Commission do promote and encourage the celebration of Earth Day on April 22, 2014, and Arbor Day on April 25, 2014, and further encourage the planting, cultivation and appreciation of trees throughout the City so as to ensure the continuation of the benefits of arboreal beauty to future generations.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
