ORDINANCE No. 2014-44

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO ONE OR MORE CONTRACTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, IMPROVEMENT, REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OF A PART OF WYLESWOOD DRIVE, ALL OF WATERBURY CIRCLE AND ALL OF WALLEYFORD CIRCLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the area of Wyleswood Drive, Walleyford Circle and Walleyford Circle has deteriorated so severely that it requires significant construction, reconstruction, improvement, repair and replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council and administration find that a comprehensive construction, reconstruction, improvement, repair and replacement is needed for the area of Wyleswood Drive, Walleyford Circle and Walleyford Circle; and

WHEREAS, the City, as a part of its 2014 Road Program has budgeted funds for this work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Service be and hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids, and after approval by the Board of Control, to enter into one or more contracts with the lowest most responsive and responsible bidder(s) for the construction, reconstruction, improvement, repair and replacement of the streets in the area of Wyleswood Drive, Walleyford Circle and Walleyford Circle all in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the City Engineer.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance be and hereby is authorized and directed to pay out such contract sum and charge the same to, and the funds therefore are hereby appropriated from the Sewer Capital Improvement Fund designated for accounting purposes as Fund No. 420 for the purpose(s) set forth I Section 1 hereinabove.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, and for the further reason that as a part of the effective implementation of the 2014 Street Maintenance and Rehabilitation Program, this project must begin at the earliest date so as to maximize repair time. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members

elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




