**MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE COUNCIL
DECEMBER 7, 2015 – 7:20p.m.**

In response to a legal notice published in The News Sun on December 3, 2015, a public hearing was held in the Council Chamber at Berea City Hall on December 7, 2015. The public hearing was called to order at 7:25p.m. by President Pro Tempore of Council Richard T. Malott, with the following members of Council present: Cheryl A. Banaszak, Nick Haschka, Margarette S. Key, Dale A. Lange, Jim Maxwell and Gene Zacharyasz. Absent: Council President Mary K. Brown. Also present: Mayor Cyril M. Kleem, Director of Recreation Marty Compton, Director of Safety and Service Barb Jones, Director of Finance Dana Kavander and Director of Law James N. Walters III.

The Clerk's certificate of compliance with C.O. Section 109 and with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code was filed with Council records in the Clerk's office.

Mr. Malott stated that the purpose of this meeting is to hear and discuss comments and/or objections to the request for D1, D2 and D3 liquor permits for The Campus Grille, located at 10 Seminary Street in Berea, Ohio. He added that the Berea Police Department has been made aware of this request and has expressed no concerns with regard to the receipt of liquor permits at this establishment.

Mr. Lange questioned whether the obtainment of a liquor license in Ward 4 mandated a public vote, and would need to be put on the ballot in an upcoming election. Mr. Walters did not believe this to be the case.

There being no further comments, Mr. Malott declared the hearing closed at 7:29p.m.
