Whereas, the regionalization of emergency dispatch centers has effectuated the need for the City to bid a fond and heartfelt farewell to the Berea Dispatchers; and



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:



SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.




