The Community Engagement Unit of the Berea Police Department invites kids in grades K – 6 to submit artwork to celebrate Police Week.

This year's theme is **"How Police Help People"**

Prizes will be given for 1st and 2nd place in each grade, plus participants will be recognized at the May 15, 2017 meeting of the Berea City Council.

#### Contest rules:

- The contest is open to any of the following:
  1. Berea residents in grades K – 6, even if they attend school outside the City;
  2. Non-Berea residents in grades K - 6 attending any school located within the City of Berea; or
  3. Non-Berea residents in grades K – 6 attending any school of the Berea City School District.
- Size of the project should be no larger than 12 x 18 in.
- Students may include crayons, chalk, colored pencils, pencils, charcoal, water colors, oil pastels or markers
- Project must be flat, two dimensional; no 3-D projects will be accepted
- A completed entry form needs to be attached to the back of the art (See attached)
- Project is to be completed by students only.
- Deadline for entries is 4 pm on Friday, May 5, 2017
- Art work may be dropped-off at the Building Department counter, located in the basement of Berea City Hall starting April 17.
