

EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM WILL CHANGE

The system the city uses to notify residents of emergencies will change as of February 1, 2015.

Berea is switching from CodeRed to ReadyNotify, which is operated by the Cuyahoga County Emergency Management Agency.

Participation is voluntary. Its main purpose is to notify residents and businesses of emergencies such as severe weather warnings, Berea messages, building closures, safety messages and Cuyahoga County messages. Users also may sign up for notifications from several different communities as well as Berea. Even if you signed up for CodeRed, **YOU MUST SIGN UP** for ReadyNotify.
