



Berea Water Meter Replacement Program

Dear Berea Water Department Customer:

Later this month, the City of Berea will begin replacing more than 4,000 water meters in homes and businesses with a state-of-the-art meter-reading system. The new meters along with meter transmitting units will automatically send water usage data to the City on a daily basis.

The new system makes sense as it will allow more accurate and consistent billing. The meters can be read on a regular basis and will greatly assist in detecting problems early. It will save time and provide peace of mind for homeowners. The City no longer will require entry into your home to read the water meter.

The City has contracted with NECO to install the new equipment. You will receive a letter from NECO asking you to schedule an appointment for the installation of the new meter in your home. Because of the large number of meters and MTUs to be installed, you may not be contacted for several months. The installation will be done by neighborhoods and is scheduled to be complete by the end of the year.

Homeowners with pit meters located in the tree lawns will not need to make an appointment.
