A RESOLUTION

APPROVING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF MICHAEL MELAMPY TO THE SHADE TREE COMMISSION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Michael Melampy, of 143 Westbridge Drive, is an Emeritus Professor in the Department of Biology at Baldwin Wallace University with over 30 years of teaching and research experience specializing in the areas of ecology and evolutionary biology; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Melampy is a member of both the Northeast Ohio Sierra Club and Sustainable Berea; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Melampy has expressed an interest in the conservation of native flora and fauna and has been active in promoting the use of native plants in suburban landscapes; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed Michael Melampy to the Shade Tree Commission, for the term ending July 12, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Berea Codified Ordinance 327.03(b) requires that the Mayor's appointments to the Shade Tree Commission be approved by City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Berea hereby approves the appointment of Michael Melampy to the Shade Tree Commission for the term expiring July 12, 2024.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the approval of this Resolution were approved in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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


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SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, and for the further reason that it is necessary to have members appointed to the Commission in order that they may begin their work. Therefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
